MK promotes five in New York

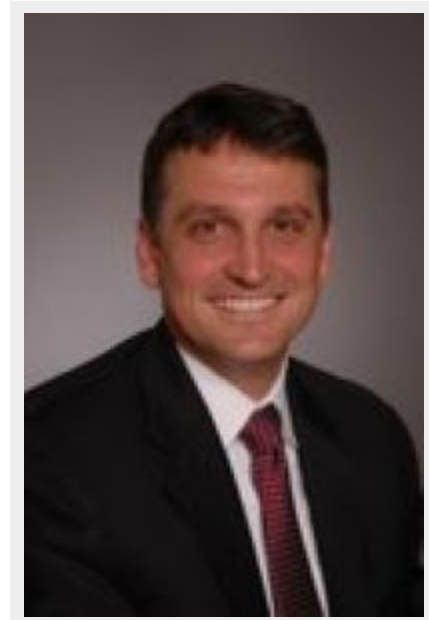
Brodhead joined Massey Knakal's Manhattan office in 1999 to spearhead the firm's efforts in the Midtown West/Clinton territory. So far, he has sold more than 50 buildings with an aggregate value of over \$300 million.
